ISO 32000-1 (PDF 1.7) ISO 32000-1 is the first ISO specification for PDF. The document is an ISO formalization of Adobe's own PDF Reference 1.7, and is technically identical to the Adobe document. On submission of PDF 1.7 to ISO for standardization in 2007, Adobe issued a summary of changes.

ISO 32000-1 currently supports a subset of XHTML for use in "Rich Text Strings" (12.7.3.4) for both annotations and form fields. A common use for such a field is to incorporate links (either entered by the author or by a future editor), but while such links may be specified by URI, the links are not treated as active.

PDF was a proprietary format controlled by Adobe until it was released as an open standard on July 1, 2008, and published by the International Organization for Standardization as ISO 32000-1:2008, at which time control of the specification passed to an ISO Committee of volunteer industry experts.

Format Description for PDF/A-2 -- A constrained form of Adobe PDF version 1.7 (as defined in ISO 32000-1)intended to be suitable for long-term preservation of page-oriented documents. Preservation of visual appearance is the primary intent; tagging to represent structure is required for conformance level A. Conformance level B is appropriate for documents scanned from paper.

PDF/A-3 allows for embedding of files of any type, but imposes requirements beyond those in "regular" PDF 1.7 files as defined by ISO 32000-1. Files that comply with these requirements are termed "associated" files; an explicit association must be made between each embedded files and the containing PDF or object or structure (e.g., image, page, or logical section) within the PDF.
