eject cd. Press Return, then wait a few seconds. The disc drive should eject the disc, and "ok" appears on the screen when the action is complete. Type: mac-boot. Press Return. Your computer starts up normally and you see the familiar Mac OS X desktop.

Then press down on its eject button to (hopefully) bring out the CD tray. Dedicated Eject Button. Sometimes, manufacturers will not provide a dedicated eject button for some reason. Instead, they provide a pinhole with a latch at the end of it. This is used to manually eject the CD tray out if you can't seem to eject it from the system.

After restart, press the eject button next to the disc slot to remove the disc. If this doesn't work, try to eject the disc using your controller. Press the Xbox button to open the guide, select Home, highlight the game that is currently inserted, and press X to eject the disc.
